

## Donald Trump: 'ISIS is not exactly located in the middle of Sweden'

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A concise argument by Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump for religious profiling has come up again and again in the wake of the Islam gaffe, the Washington Post [said](#) . It's about Sweden.
